Why

- To ensure our pupils have an understanding of the world as a physical space.
- Our pupils will be able to make comparisons between different places around the world, those familiar to them and those which are not.
- To allow our children to confidently identify different geographical features in the world around them.

How

- Give the children opportunities to develop their skills both through practical experiences and through research.
- Teachers to have planned sequenced lessons building on previous learning.
- Through high quality teaching allowing the pupils to develop good subject knowledge and Geographical skills such as map reading.

What

- First-hand experience in map skill and field work to provide real life opportunities to apply understanding.
- High quality resources which provide accurate information for the pupils.
- Teacher's subject knowledge allows for cross curricular learning opportunities as often as possible. I.e. links with Science or religious festivals around the world.
